As we step into a new financial year, it is important to reflect not only on the achievements of the past year but also on the growing challenges we continue to face as a Business Improvement District.

Since WGC BID's inception in 2017, our goal has remained unchanged: to ensure that Welwyn Garden City town centre remains vibrant, welcoming, and economically resilient. However, 2024 proved to be a more difficult year than anticipated. We faced a significant reduction in financial support from various sponsorships, and the levy collection fell short of projections. This presented considerable pressures on our budget and forced us to reassess how we deliver services to our levy payers.

Despite these constraints, we worked hard to offset the shortfall. Through proactive engagement and creative thinking, we secured additional income from new sponsors, and increased revenue through our events and markets. While we closed the financial year with a deficit of £37,000, we are proud to say that we still managed to deliver a full range of projects and benefits for our businesses.

From flagship events like the World Food Festival to targeted business support and practical services such as recycling and training, we remained focused on ensuring that every pound spent provided tangible returns. Our collaboration with stakeholders remains strong, though we recognise that maintaining these partnerships will require ongoing effort and adaptability in an increasingly challenging economic environment.

2025 will be a pivotal year for the BID. With limited resources, our focus will be on prioritising high-impact projects, maintaining open lines of communication with levy payers, and ensuring that the BID continues to represent the voice and interests of the business community.

We remain committed to delivering value and advocating for Welwyn Garden City in the months ahead — but we must also be honest: sustaining our work will require continued support, careful planning, and a collective effort to meet the challenges ahead

### 1. Accounting Policies

#### 1.1. Basis of Preparation of Financial Statements

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the FRS 102 Section 1A Small Entities - The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland and the Companies Act 2006.

#### 1.2. Turnover

Income is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable, excluding discounts, rebates, value added tax and other sales taxes.

#### 1.3. Tangible Fixed Assets and Depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are measured at cost less accumulated depreciation and any accumulated impairment losses. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost of the fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives on the following bases:

Plant & Machinery 25% on cost Computer Equipment 25% on cost

#### 1.4. Reserves

The directors have designated that certain of the company's funds will be required in order to meet the cost of renewing the BID in 2027. To this end they have set up two separate reserves to meet the expected costs of renewal and the additional costs that will be incurred should the application be unsuccessful
